Any supporting information that could help the evaluation panel understand and appreciate the merits of the candidate would be desirable. Past services to SNIC should be highlighted. Publication list should be selective rather than comprehensive.

(E) SUPPORTING LETTERS (optional)

The candidate may submit up to FIVE letters of support, each of which should be no more than 1-page.
